






Elements of a "fracking-friendly" frame:

- "Economic impacts"—but only the positives
 - Puts jobs before health
- "Choice"
 - Assumes that people can relocate, despite possible decreased housing values
- "Sacrifice of the few for the good of the many"

"Energy has to come from somewhere. The needs of the many may outweigh the inconvenience of the few who live near the exploration efforts. This is not an ideal situation for all residents, but it is the reality"



Human rights and fracking

- Declarations of fracking's violations of human rights
- Declarations of rights to health and home apply to fracking



Human Rights, Health and Housing Rights, and Fracking

The impact of fracking on human rights has been affirmed by governments and scholars, and established rights to health and housing are incompatible with fracking impacts.


Already affected by fracking?
