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**MEDIA ADVISORY: Community Organizations to Host Public Meeting
on Constitution Pipeline Proposal and Public Health Impacts**

COBLESKILL, N.Y. — Waterfall Unity Alliance (Stop the Con) and [Environmental Health Project](#) (EHP) will host a public meeting on Tuesday, August 18, on the SUNY Cobleskill campus to discuss the proposed Constitution Pipeline. The meeting will cover the federal permitting process for the pipeline and its potential environmental and public health impacts on Schoharie County and surrounding communities.

Presenters will provide an overview of the pipeline's history, the current application before the [Federal Energy Regulatory Commission](#) (FERC), and the health impacts associated with oil and gas development and the broader fossil fuel supply chain. The program will conclude with an audience question-and-answer session.
